

## 2010 Low Income Cost-Sharing Subsidy (LICS) Levels for Each Drug Payment Stage

As shown in the table below, there are three stages for your Part D prescription drug coverage. How much you pay for a drug depends on which of these stages you are in at the time you get a prescription filled or refilled.
